There exists for the BPL Woods library building, "...a historic preservation easement coheld by the Vermont Housing and Conservation Board and the Preservation Trust of Vermont that covers the exterior facades and significant interior features of the structure." A motion was made to approve the statement. Motion approved.

"In 2015 the Library received a \$20,000 bequest from the Frances Hyde estate. The bequest allows the Library Trustees to use, as they see fit, 80% of the annual income of the bequest. The remaining 20% of the annual income is to be added back to the original \$20,000 capital. In August 2015, The Trustees established the Frances P Hyde "Nonprofit Endowment Fund" at the Vermont Community Foundation by transferring the \$20,000 to the Foundation. Each year the Library must direct the reinvestment of 20% of the Annual Income back into the Frances P. Hyde Fund."

L. Coffin motioned, M. Priestley seconded A motion was made to adjourn the Annual Meeting. Motion accepted.
