# **Mission Statement**

The Bradford Public Library is committed to supporting and enhancing learning, creativity, and opportunities for personal growth and community connections with reliable information and resources, and the support necessary to navigate those resources in a safe and welcoming environment.

## **Administrative:**

On Wednesday, November 5, I [Gail] was invited to speak at a women's group meeting in the Fairlee Town Hall on behalf of the library. I took this opportunity to talk about the history of the library, our services and programs, how the library is funded, and our dependence on grants, donations, and the *Annual Appeal*. The RONDO club was founded by women in 1920 as a political club to advocate for women's right to vote. It now is a charitable club raising money for ten Upper Valley charities annually. At this meeting, BPL was nominated as one of the charitable organizations to receive a donation this year. The group will choose ten organizations at their December meeting. Fingers crossed...
